The firm was founded by Mohammad Jaradat, a former public prosecutor, judge, and President of the Court, who later advised the Prime Ministry on the legislation aligning Jordanian commercial law with the Kingdom’s WTO commitments. Since 2008 the practice has been led by Abdullah Jaradat, extending into international arbitration, investment structuring, and cross-border transactions.

OUR APPROACH

How we work with clients.

The practice rests on three choices: partner involvement, document precision, and direct counsel, carried through a clear four-step engagement.

- 1** **Initial enquiry**
Enquiries reach the firm by phone, WhatsApp, Telegram, or email. The intake team responds within six working hours during the office's working week.
 - 2** **Conflicts review and scoping**
Each new matter is checked against the firm's conflicts policy and reviewed for scope. The team confirms whether the firm can act and identifies the practice areas required.
 - 3** **Engagement letter**
Where the firm accepts the engagement, an engagement letter sets out the scope of work, the fee arrangement, the team assigned, and the terms of the relationship before work begins.
 - 4** **Coordinated delivery**
The lead partner coordinates the file, with supporting lawyers contributing where their expertise is required. Cross-border matters carry the Managing Partner's direct involvement.
